Most office spaces are separate offices, in which the cross contamination is reduced, however instructors and students are to ensure that chairs in the office and classroom are separated by two metres where possible for lessons. Meetings can be done potentially by skype call if enough IT is available for stake holders. Where stake holders need to be in a room ensure that the largest room available in the real estate is booked, this may mean moving traditional venues. Ensure that the rooms and office is ventilated and ensure where practicable that seats arranged two metres apart. Remind participants to spread out, during smoke breaks and in tea/coffee areas. Practice washing hands prior to meeting or lecture for 20 seconds. 2m distancing should continue to be observed in smoking areas around working areas.	3	2	6	Yes	Where it is not possible to follow the social distancing guidelines in full in relation to an activity, the Club Secretary should consider whether that activity needs to continue, and if so, take all the mitigating actions possible to reduce the risk of transmission between students and instructors If a 2meter distance cannot be maintained, instructors and students should work side by side, or facing away from each other, rather than face to face if possible. Instructors and students should be reminded to only come into work if they are well and no one in their household is self-isolating. In addition, instructors and students should be encouraged to regularly wash their hands with soap and water as often as possible and for a minimum of 20 seconds every time. To help with this, additional pop-up handwashing stations or facilities should be made available, providing soap, water and hand sanitizer.
