Ensure that no boxer competes in any other combat sport except that of Amateur Boxing. Also, that no club boxer, coach, or official participates and assists at any events not licensed by the London ABA

The club will be held responsible, and action will be taken for any trouble and could be fined up to £1,000 or suspended.
